The Application for Accommodation is the first step in the accommodation process. Per the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), an academic accommodation is a reasonable modification or adjustment that enables a qualified person with a disability to gain equal access to the academic environment. In an effort to determine eligibility for accommodation under the ADA, the Office of Accessibility Services will require documentation of diagnosis from a current or treating provider.
